CHASING BIRDS ISN'T HARMLESS FUN.

If nesting, shorebirds will likely abandon nests when harassed. This action poses a significant threat to the entire colony!



SOME BIRDS FLY UP TO 3 DAYS NON-STOP.

Many of these birds are flying at night and are feeding, and resting on Anna Maria Island during the day to prepare themselves for the demanding migration flight.

4 CHASING BIRDS DEPLETES THEIR RESERVES.

Disrupting birds at rest on the shore puts the birds in danger by exhausting them at a time they face a difficult undertaking.
